Subject: Request for No Objection Certificate for Conducting Million Cricket League (MCL)

Dear Sir,

LOBA Cricket Club, registered, recognized and authorized by the Afghanistan Cricket Board to operate, play and organize cricket events in Afghanistan, having its principal place of business at Shashaheed Street 1, Near Azizi Bank, District 8, Kabul, Afghanistan (hereinafter "LOBA"); LCC has the legal certificate and rights to hold Million Cricket League in Afghanistan. We have already organized four edition of the tournament in 2013, 2014, 2015, 2017 and are going to launch the 5th Edition in Khost National Cricket Stadium Starting from 5th 18th November 2020.

The 5th edition of MCA will have 7 teams that will be franchised to private companies or business individuals, the players' selection will be held through draft process. The league will live broadcast on one of the local television and the matches of MCL-2020 season will be played in Khost National Cricket Stadium, Afghanistan.

The league consists of the following seven teams. The final names and numbers of teams will confirm prior to draft.

MCL confirms that all matches will be played as per MCC law, ICC T20 playing condition /code of conducts. The league organizer will be responsible for covering ground fess as per mutual agreement between MCL /ACB, pay fee to all technical and admin staff, and provide medical services in the ground to all concerns.

50% of the players' league fee will be given prior the start of the league and 25% in the middle of the league and the remaining 25% of the fee will be given at the end of league.

If any contracted player get injured during the league, the recovery cost of the players will be 50% covered by the team owner and 50% by ACB, for the non-contracted player all the cost will be bear by team owner.
